What is a Tax Credit?

A tax credit is not a deduction (which reduces your taxable gross income).

A state tax credit is taken directly out of the income taxes you owe the State of Oregon.

FOR EXAMPLE: If your state income tax is \$3,000 and you qualify for a tax credit of \$1,000, you owe the State of Oregon only \$2,000.

Education tax credits are already available in other states. Tens of thousands of low-income students have already gained access to a high-quality education due to these programs.
